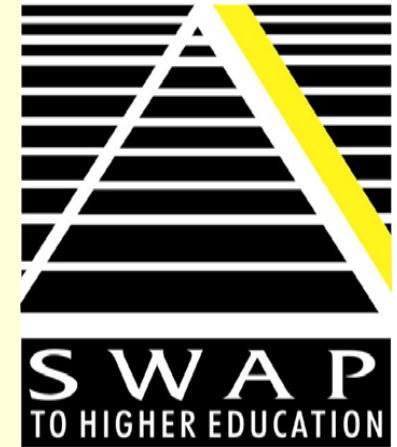

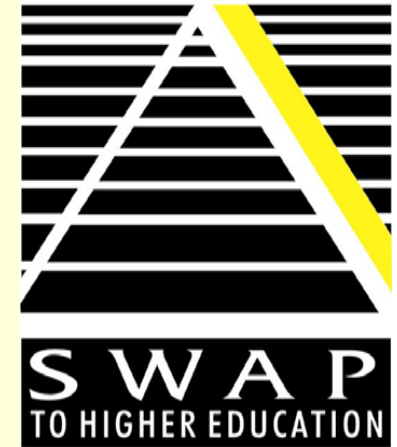

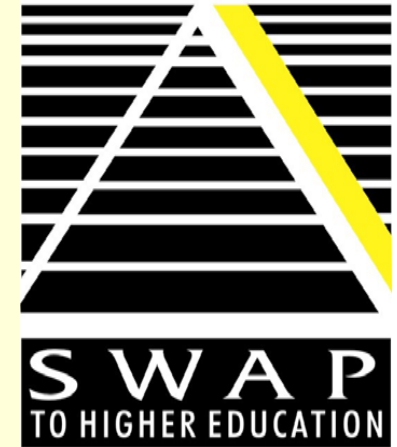
Scoping Exercise Remit

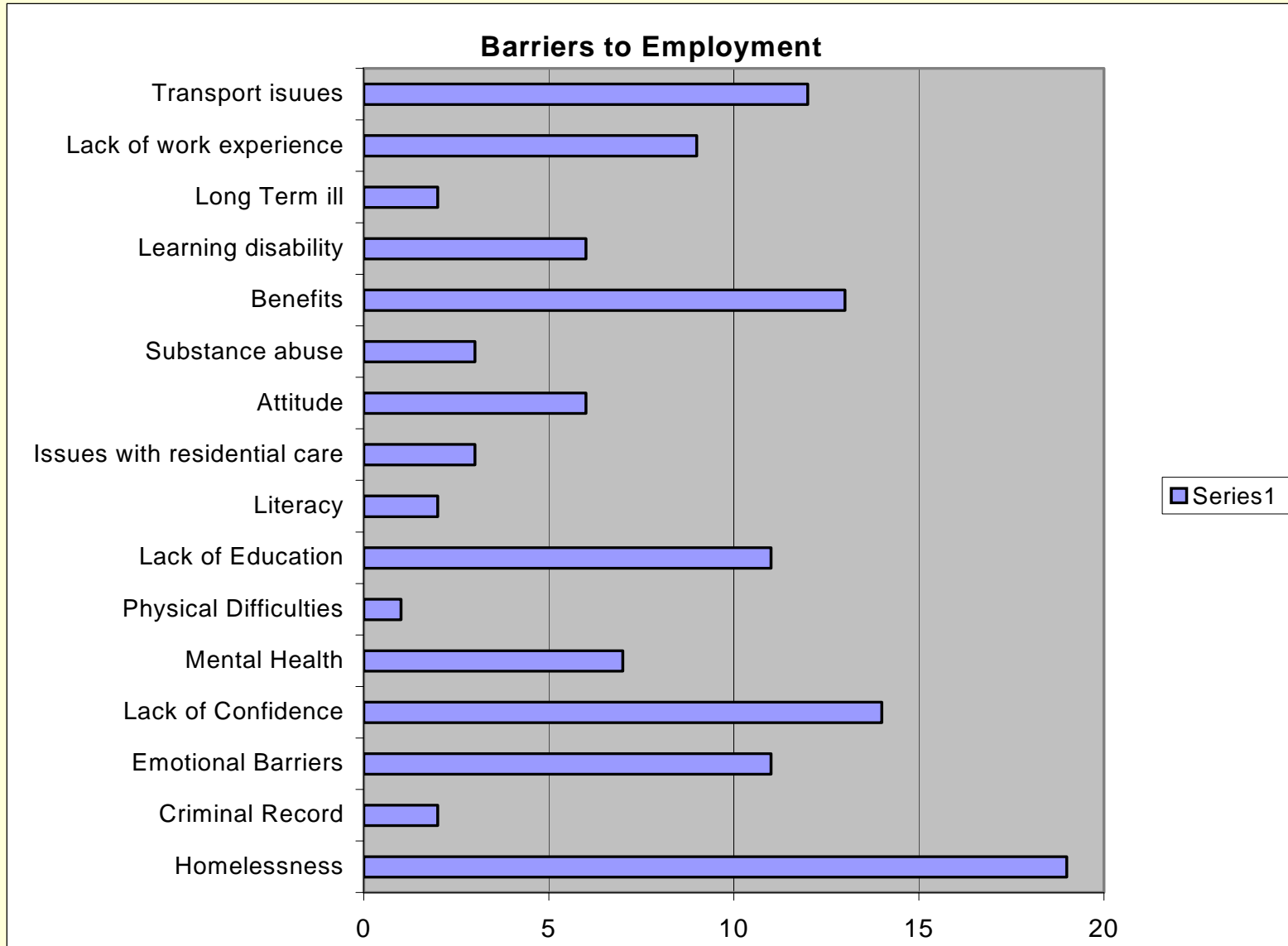

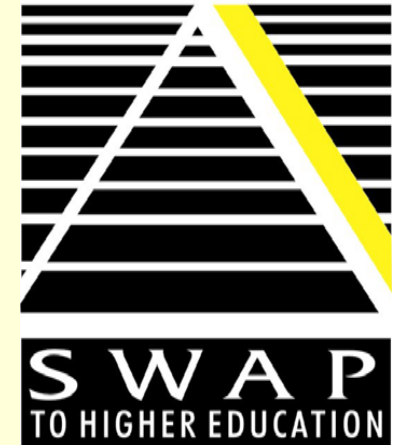
